

News from Monkhill Methodist Church

Members at the Chapel decided not to reopen the Chapel for weekly services at the beginning of January as was originally the intention. Not an easy decision but sensible we thought facing rising infection levels. Our decision was confirmed as the correct one, a week later, when The Methodist Church recommended that all their Churches be closed once again.

We were pleased to be able to join with St Mary's Beaumont for the United Parish Christmas Service which, although quite different in many ways, provided comfort and a sense of normality in the traditional Christmas story and message.

We are sorry that the Annual Pancake Lunch on Saturday 13 February is cancelled but pleased to report that the new kitchen facilities are finished. We are looking forward to the next "Lunch with Us" when they can be utilised.

The Stewards at the Chapel keep in touch and update members and adherents by way of a weekly e-mailed newsletter that is uploaded onto the Parish web-site. The Chapel also has a What's Ap group for quick messaging and for passing on various witticisms that keep us amused in these trying days.

News from the Circuit

We are continuing to support the North Cumbria Methodist Circuit on-line via Zoom, Facebook or telephone with Sunday morning and evening worship, fellowship that is Tea@10 on a Tuesday, Wednesday morning prayer meetings at 9am, together with the various meetings taking place during this time of challenge and change. (All these details and much more appear on the North Cumbria Methodist Circuit Facebook page.)

The North Cumbria Circuit is facing change and is challenged to move forward to encompass these changes. The proposal is for Churches in the Circuit to work together in "hub groups". Monkhill would be in the Solway Hub together with Thurstonfield, Dalston and Thursby and Port Carlisle. We are all already in the Carlisle Rural Mission Community. This working together more closely should basically mean each Church spending less time on routine matters, meetings and finance leaving more time for being "Church", enjoying "fellowship" with one another and doing "Mission".

It is also proposed that the North Cumbria Circuit, under the leader-ship and guidance of our Superintendent Minister David Newlove, joins with the Wigton Circuit from 1 September 2021to form a larger Circuit in the North of Cumbria. This proposal will be put to both Circuit meetings simultaneously and if both support it, it is hoped the processes will complete in August.

Hands, Face, Space, *Grace* – Jesus said love your neighbour as yourself (Matthew ch. 22 .v 29).

We know times are difficult and confusing but be kind, be gracious and be loving with one another and yourself. Show grace to those around you to keep each other safe.

We hope and pray that by the next magazine edition, we will have seen a significant reduction in infection rates and hospital admissions with the roll-out of Covid-19 vaccinations.

Rectory Ramblings

So just as the Vaccines had begun rolling out, new variants of Covid have plunged us into the worst health situation yet, and this time North Cumbria is as badly hit as the rest of the country!

Once again there is the temptation to batten down the hatches and put everything on hold until 'better times' come.

Of course, in love for others (and for our own good) we do need to be wise and responsible in our social distancing etc. Broadly speaking the 'benefits' of isolating outweigh the 'costs'.

But it is to our loss (and that of others) if we put our lives on hold - if we don't make the effort to keep in contact by phone/ email/ Zoom etc with those we would have face-to-face beforehand.

Let's not let the strong tides of Covid turn us into emotional islands, even if we are physical ones.

The God of all the Universe is the God of **Today**, not just eternity past and future. His purposes for us continue Today – that we love and allow ourselves to be loved. In Deuteronomy 10:13 God's spokesperson told the people [years after God gave them]: "...observe the Lord's commands and decrees that I am giving you today for your own good..." Those commands are both the 'right living' commands that reflect the good character of God (e.g. the 10 commandments), but also Jesus' command to take up our cross and follow Him daily, and

'Come to me all who are weary and burdened, and I will give you rest' (Matthew 11:28) ... For as we learn in Hebrews 13:8 "Jesus Christ is the same yesterday and today and for ever." His love for us is a 'now' and always love. So, His call and His promises are always Today.

It is a theme shown in Psalm 95:7-8 "Today, if only you would hear his voice, 'Do not harden your hearts" (& picked up in Hebrews).

Today we have meaning, Today we have purpose, Today we have opportunity, Today God is speaking to us. What will we do today?

Lord God, strong & kind, in you alone I find my value and purpose and hope and joy. By the Holy Spirit of Jesus, help me to fix my eyes on Him, and be guided by Him in prayers and acts of love TODAY. Amen






