

Often it is what is unsaid that leaves the biggest impression. For years now our local churches have said that we exist to "Help everyone enjoy life in all its fulness through being disciples of Jesus".

But I wonder if an unspoken qualifier has been 'heard' louder than our vision – (as long as you fit in with how we do this)!

Have you felt that a church gathering had a particular style or culture?

If so, did it make you feel like you didn't fit in, or couldn't be yourself even though you do want to live more of a truly 'good' life like Jesus?

In one sense that experience is perfectly understandable, because every human gathering naturally develops a certain style or culture... BUT it's also a tragedy, because Christian churches should be different.

We should have a **super**-natural culture where the Holy Spirit works so that all kinds of people and all kinds of style are united in someone greater than us all – Jesus ©

So, I want to apologise for when I and our churches have been merely welcoming in an Assimilating (you fit in with us) way, rather than being truly Accommodating (we'll change so you can be part of us).

While keeping what is good news for everyone – God's love for the world shown in Jesus – we need to hear from you what non-essentials we could change (for how we express our faith & questions, and together respond is always up for grabs). We probably don't realise the half of what gets in your way. What do you think? Please let us know.

Father God,

Forgive us for when we try and fit other people into our human boxes and our ways of doing things, rather than appreciating the rich variety you have created, and truly seeking the flourishing of all in Jesus.

FOUNDATIONS – Episode 8

In our mini-series on Christian basics we've seen how in the Bible God says We're 'matter' that matters ... beloved lovers... messed up masterpieces ... The best sacrifice is love in the service of others and that God's purpose are all about Jesus ... and His people ... and welcoming all who trust Jesus into His perfect rest.

Once in a while we'll notice a real change in someone. They'll walk a bit more upright, with more of a spring in their step. They will smile more than they used to. And rather than just share their struggles, they will take time to ask how you are.

That happens as someone gets a renewed sense of purpose or direction for their life, a clearer sense of identity and confidence. It may come from getting a new pet or hobby, a new job or a new relationship

And because the Christian faith is essentially a growing relationship with God, its no wonder that when we first encounter Jesus, or deepen that relationship, then we too will be changed for the better from the inside out, having a life that is being transformed now (Romans 12:2). Jesus talks about it in terms of being 'born again' (John 3:3) - the 'just me' life gone, and the 'me & God' life begun – this is the symbolism of 'drowning and rising' in Baptism services. And just as couples increasingly share more of the same characteristics, the closer they become (e.g. expressions, turns of phrase, interests), so we share more and more of God's characteristics as we mature in our faith (the Fruit of the Holy Spirit of God living in us – See Galatians 5:22-23).

The Christian Faith then is one of future hope (the perfect 'rest' we considered last month) but also of present transformation from the inside out. We don't just put on a 'Sunday best' mask of external behaviours, no, our behaviour changes the more our heart becomes like Jesus' – more merciful, generous, kind, patient, joyful, loving...

Father God, Thank you that you do not leave us unchanged, but transform us to the best we can be as your Holy Spirit makes us more like Jesus. May people see more of your inner beauty in me. Amen

Loving communities open to everyone willing to be loved by Jesus

Gravestones are really important. They are a lasting commemoration of a valuable life now ended, a sign of thankfulness and loss (that signposts love), and a focus for healthy mourning.

But Gravestones are also my nemesis, a part of my work that drains the life out of me, and causes huge relational pain!

For Churchyards have legal regulations about what can and can't be put in them, and whilst I have no say in those regulations, I am legally obliged to be the gatekeeper for them. So, when I want to offer comfort, I can be seen as the 'baddie' who says 'that is not allowed' to grieving families who just want to do right by their loved one. I hate it.

To add to that, the regulations change from time to time, so families can see an existing gravestone and choose a similar one assuming that will be fine, only to be told that is no longer allowed. For instance:

gravestones now need to be made of stone quarried in the UK, but some types of stone already in graveyards can only be got from abroad (so are no longer allowed). And gravestones are no longer permitted to have a mirror finish (reflective), which

had been normal for decades before.



Now there are reasons for these changes (environmental etc.) and without any rules then what one person thinks is tasteful may 'ruin' the beauty of the graveyard for others but I do wish that I wasn't the one stuck in the middle

Unless there are changes in the law, this is one area where I can be far less 'Accommodating' than we want our Churches to be in areas of style etc. So please be aware of this if you hear people understandably aggrieved, or if you are approaching putting a gravestone up. And as always, if you have any questions (including asking for a copy of the regulations) then please let me know.


and sale the following day.




